Over the years with on ground experience in planting in frost locations across the Sunshine Coast. I have noted the below species are the most resilient to any frost damage that may occur.

Canopy –

Apananthe philippinensis – Rough-leaved Elm
Diploglottis australe – Native Tamarind
Flindersia australis – Crows Ash
Eucalyptus tereticornis – Red Gum
Eucalyptus resinifera – Red Mahogany
Grevillea robusta – Silky Oak
Lophostemom confertus – Brush Box
Melaleuca bracteata – Black Tea Tree
Polyscias elegans – Celery Wood
Rhodospheara rhodanthema – Deep Yellow Wood
Toona australis – Red Cedar
